The Last Supper is a late 15th-century mural painting by Italian artist Leonardo da Vinci housed in the refectory of the Convent of Santa Maria delle Grazie in Milan, Italy. It is one of the Western world's most recognizable paintings. The work is assumed to have been started around 1495–96

Infant Baptisms

There is a backlog of baptisms to deal with – and so it will be necessary to book two baptisms together.

Baptism is the first of the three Sacraments of Initiation in the Catholic Church – the other two being First Holy Communion and Confirmation.

Even if adults have missed out on Baptism, First Holy Communion or Confirmation, it is not too late – because all the Sacraments of Initiation can also be received by adults.

There will be a course for adults starting in September 2021– the RCIA Programme.

THE LAST SUPPER (see front cover)

The Last Supper by Leonardo shows the reaction given by each apostle when Jesus said one of them would betray him.

From left to right:

Bartholomew, James, son of Alphaeus, & Andrew form a group of three; all are surprised.

Judas Iscariot, Peter, & John form another group of three. **Judas** is clutching a small bag, perhaps signifying the silver given to him as payment to betray Jesus. **Peter** wears an expression of anger and appears to be holding a knife & is leaning towards **John** and touching him on the shoulder, in a reference to John's Gospel where he signals the "beloved disciple" to ask Jesus who is to betray him. The youngest apostle, **John**, appears to swoon and lean towards Peter. **Thomas, James the Greater & Philip** are the next group of three. **Thomas** is clearly upset; the raised index finger foreshadows his incredulity of the Resurrection. **James the Greater** looks stunned, with his arms in the air. Meanwhile, **Philip** appears to be requesting some explanation.

Matthew, Thaddeus (Jude) & Simon the Zealot are the final group of three. Both **Thaddeus and Matthew** are turned toward **Simon**, perhaps to find out if he has any answer to their initial questions.

Leonardo reportedly used the likenesses of people in and around Milan for the painting's figures. The convent's prior complained of Leonardo's "laziness" as he wandered the streets to find a criminal to base Judas on. Leonardo responded that if he could find no one else, the prior would make a suitable model
