FR FRANCIS WRITES

The Bishops have told us that while
the COVID-19 Emergency still
continues no one is obliged to attend
Mass on a Sunday.

As you all know, Fr Jean-Laurent is
having chemotherapy – and he thanks
you for all your prayers. He has been
advised not to concelebrate Mass in
church. So he will be celebrating Mass in
the Presbytery.

Two months ago I was told by my GP
that because of my age & underlying
medical conditions, I need to shield
until the beginning of August.

This means that I **CANNOT** distribute
Holy Communion at Mass at present –
so we **MUST** have 2 Extraordinary
Ministers at each Mass to distribute
Holy Communion.
