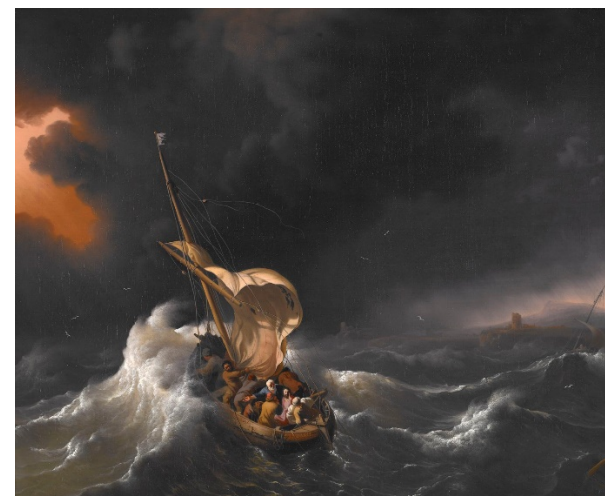

Candidates for Confirmation 2021 should sign for themselves.

St John Fisher (1469 – 22 June 1535)

John Fisher was a bishop, cardinal, and theologian. He was also an academic & also served as Chancellor of the University of Cambridge. He was canonized a saint by Pope Pius XI in 1935 with Thomas More. *When Henry VIII tried to divorce his wife, Catherine of Aragon, Fisher became the Queen's chief supporter & appeared on the Queen's behalf in the legates' court, where he startled the audience by the directness of his language. He declared that, like St John the Baptist, he was ready to die on behalf of the indissolubility of marriage.* Fisher was subsequently executed by order of Henry VIII for refusing to accept him as the supreme head of the Church of England and for upholding the Catholic Church's doctrine of papal supremacy.
Erasmus said of John Fisher: "He is incomparable for uprightness of life, learning & greatness of soul."

St Thomas More (1478 – 6 July 1535)

The son of a successful lawyer & judge. At the age of 14 he went to Oxford University to study Greek & Latin. After two years, at his father's insistence, he began legal training in London and in 1502, he was called to the Bar & in 1504 elected to Parliament. In 1523 he was elected Speaker of the House of Commons & succeeded Cardinal Wolsey as Lord Chancellor in 1529 – making him the most important political figure in the country after the King. More was executed only five days after a rigged trial & convicted purely on the testimony of Richard Rich (who gave false evidence on oath) for refusing to accept Henry VIII as the Supreme Head of the Church in England. His friend Erasmus described More's character as "more pure than any snow".
