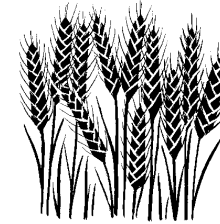

Our church is open again for Mass. But in order to maximize our seating capacity, we have decided to opt to social distance "1 metre +". Our present maximum capacity is 104.

But this also means that we need to wear face masks in church.

Some other parishes have decided to social distance "2 metres". This means that people there do not have to wear face masks. But it also means that very few people are allowed into their church.

If we decided to social distance "2 metres" we would have a maximum capacity of only 35 – and we would then have to turn people away.

FR FRANCIS WRITES

I have been told by my GP that because of my age & medical conditions, I need to shield. In addition I need to be very careful not to introduce any sickness into the Presbytery because Fr Jean Laurent is continuing chemotherapy there.

This means that I CANNOT distribute Holy Communion at Mass at present – so we NEED 2 Extraordinary Ministers at each Sunday Mass to distribute Holy Communion.

We need the following able bodied volunteers for ALL Masses

- 2 Stewards
 - 2 Extraordinary Ministers
 - 1 Server & 1 Reader
- Please ring Fr Francis on 020 8529 1804 or Helen on 07714 108 025 if you can help

There are some changes:

- no Holy Water
- no congregational singing or hymn books
- no Bidding Prayers
- no Collection (churns for the collection are at the entrance & exit to the church)
- no Offertory Procession
- Communion under One Kind only
- Extraordinary Ministers will sanitize their hands at the altar before distributing Holy Communion
- all windows will be open
- all benches are now one metre apart
