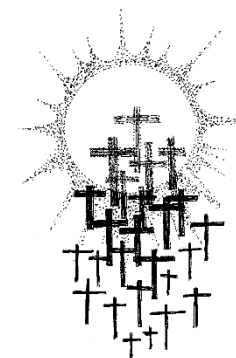

MESSAGE FROM THE BISHOP ON POSSIBLE RE-OPENING OF CHURCHES FOR PRIVATE PRAYER

1. Before any church re-opens the parish priest must have returned to the Diocese the questionnaire sent by the Bishop containing 81 questions.

2. **The guidance only allows personal prayer in churches** - i.e. an individual going into the church to pray on their own and not as part of a group. Collective or communal prayer (including a priest or any other person leading devotions or prayer) and regular scheduled services are not permitted at this time.

- **Social distancing** must apply at all times with people being two metres apart from one another in all directions.

- **At least two stewards must be present in the church throughout the time it is open for prayer.** These two stewards should not be drawn from those instructed to be shielding or from vulnerable groups (ie people over 70 or people who have been advised by their GP to isolate).

- **Alcohol hand gel** should be provided at doors with people being asked to sanitise their hands.

- All printed material which is not intended to be taken away must be removed from the church.

- **Toilet facilities should remain closed.**

- There should be **no holy water** in church stoups.

- **The church must be cleaned fully at least once a day.**

3. **The guidance applies only to churches, not halls.** Halls must remain closed except for the special circumstance of use by a school or a registered pre-school or childcare organisation.

4. **Communion to the sick** is still not permitted.
